Conference & Grants Details

APOYOnline – Association for Heritage Preservation of the Americas, Inc. is pleased to announce our **4**th **Regional Conference**, which will be entirely virtual and take place from November 12-15, 2021. The conference will be the first ever for students and emerging professionals in Latin America, with the theme "Connect, Empower, Transform: a Virtual Conference for Students and Emerging Professionals in Cultural Heritage."

Students in cultural heritage have been integral to the success of our recent regional conferences by contributing unique research and promoting lively discussion. By organizing this first ever regional conference for students, APOYOnline looks to empower, encourage and bring together emerging professionals, students, and future students of cultural heritage programs in Latin America, North America, the Caribbean, Portugal and Spain.

APOYOnline and its members have reaped the benefits of networking and connecting across countries and continents over our 30-year history. A goal of this conference is to promote these professional and personal connections early so they can grow and develop over time. The conference will be an ideal opportunity to connect students not only in Spanish- and Portuguese-speaking countries, but also with students all over the globe, including individuals from the Caribbean French- and English-speaking islands.

This conference has been made possible by the generous contributions of many sponsors, donors, and collaborators listed below. We would especially like to thank the Andrew W. The virtual conference will take place November 12th-15th, 2021, and there will be three components to the program: 1) the presentation of selected works by participants in the form of oral presentations or posters, 2) panels with international experts and students concerning pertinent topics in cultural heritage, and 3) professional development workshops offered by a team of international experts. The conference will also include time for networking in breakout sessions to encourage cultural exchange and discussion.

The panels, papers, and posters will address the following topics:

- 1. Vision & Trends in Cultural Heritage
- 2. Diversity/Equity/Inclusion/Accessibility in Cultural Heritage
- 3. Global Connections & Opportunities
- 4. Sustainability in Cultural Heritage

Originally planned to take place in the Dominican Republic, the now completely virtual conference will include virtual tours of cultural sites and preservation spaces to share the cultural richness of the Domincan Republic and the issues faced by cultural heritage professionals there.

Professional Development Workshops

The final day of the conference will include professional development workshops presented by professionals across heritage fields. The workshop schedule will be posted soon and will include workshops on leadership skills, environmental management, community engagement, job interview preparation, how to write a senior thesis and scholarly papers, how to prepare a resume, communication and team building, marketing, public speaking, vision board for your career, among others. Upon conference registration, participants will be able to sign up for 3 workshops (space is limited in each). Workshop participation is included in the registration fee and will include a certificate for each workshop attended.

Manos a la Obra

The Pre-Conference Activity will include the APOYOnline special initiative "MANOS A LA OBRA" ("Helping Hands"), a volunteer-based, community-focused initiative that aims to assist a local cultural institution with its preservation needs in the location of the regional conference. Conference participants may volunteer time and expertise to carry out basic collections care activities. For this edition of the event, volunteers will virtually work with the Ateneo Amantes de la Luz, a public library in Santiago de los Caballeros, Dominican Republic. This event carries no extra cost but will require a separate registration, space is limited.

Languages:

The Conference and Professional Development Workshops will be offered in Spanish, Portuguese, and English, with simultaneous interpretation when possible.

Call to submit papers/posters:

Those interested in sharing their work through presentations or posters may submit an abstract related to one of the four themes of the Conference:

- 1. Vision & Trends in Cultural Heritage
- 2. Diversity/Equity/Inclusion/Accessibility in Cultural Heritage
- 3. Global Connections & Opportunities
- 4. Sustainability in Cultural Heritage

Abstracts can be submitted in Portuguese, Spanish or English and must be submitted by **July 31, 2021** (EXTENDED DEADLINE: AUGUST 20, 2021). Selected candidates for papers/posters will be informed by e-mail by August 31, 2021.

Candidates may select the option of presenting a paper or poster. An international selection committee consisting of professionals from the field of cultural heritage preservation will make the final selection. Poster authors will have an opportunity to briefly present their work during virtual poster sessions throughout the Conference.

Required materials for abstract submissions:

- Submission form: All candidates must submit a completed Paper/Poster Submission Form, available at the link below.
- Upload the following via the link in the submission form:
 - Submit a 500-word or less abstract for an oral presentation or poster related to one of the Conference topics. Abstracts must contain a brief description of the topic, objectives, methodology used, and advances/conclusions obtained or expected. The file submitted should not exceed 1MB.

o For students only:

- Enrollment letter: Submit a signed letter from the educational institution demonstrating enrollment.
- Curriculum vitae (CV): Maximum 3 pages, should not exceed 1MB, please do not include photographs.
- Letter of interest: Demonstrate in 500 words or less how your participation in the Conference will contribute to your career and how you will share and disseminate the knowledge obtained during the Conference.

Grants / Scholarships
